Alderney Gambling Control Commission appoints new CEO.

The Alderney Gambling Control Commission has appointed Mr. André Wilsenach as its new Chief Executive with effect from 15th January 2002.

Mr. Wilsenach joins the Commission from South Africa. He has served on the South African Lotteries and Gambling Board and was the first chief Executive of the provincial Gaming Board of Mpumalanga. He has also served on the National Gambling Board of South Africa, was a founder member of the Southern African Gambling Regulators Association and is well known as regulator and a consultant on gaming and regulatory compliance matters.

The former Chief Executive, Mr. Moran Chapman, remains available to the Commission as a consultant.
