Memorandum of Understanding between Alderney Gambling Control Commission, Channel Islands and Nevada Gaming Control Board

The Alderney Gambling Control Commission (AGCC) and Nevada Gaming Control Board (NGCB) agreed terms for future cooperation between the two gaming regulatory bodies.

The agreement, which was executed yesterday, paves the way for enhanced cooperation in the field of gaming regulation.

The agreement provides for cooperation in the areas of sharing of information, expertise, knowledge and skills as well as exchange visits and training.

Mark Lipparelli, Chairman of the NGCB, commented, “We are fortunate and appreciative of our relationships with governments around the globe similar to what we have developed with the AGCC. As our licensees continue their global expansion and among new business sectors, we must adapt as an agency. Formalizing these distant relationships is a benefit to all involved from many perspectives including cost, time and quality.”

Considering the Nevada Board’s long-standing history and experience of regulating gaming, we are very pleased to have formalised our cooperation with the Nevada regulator.
