Description:

Alderney, has established itself as a leading offshore jurisdiction for the electronic gambling industry. The Alderney Gambling Control Commission is an independent, non-political body, established to regulate the e-gambling industry operating from the island. The regulatory regime is focused on ensuring the integrity of the industry, the fairness of the games, the control and security of the gaming operation and its social responsibility towards the young and vulnerable.

To assist in achieving these objectives, the Commission wishes to appoint a person with an operational background in the gaming industry, or possibly in e-commerce, to the position of Regulatory Inspector.

The successful applicant will be required to undertake the following functions:

- Conducting assessments of the control systems of applicants and licensees,
- Assessing proposals for the controls and operating procedures of relevant on-line gaming and betting operations;
- Inspecting and auditing of licensed operations against their approved controls and procedures;
- Monitoring the operational performance of licensed companies; and
- Assisting in the development of the regulatory regime

The successful applicant will work in a small team of inspectors with diverse professional backgrounds, and will liaise regularly with gambling operators, applicants for licences, software providers, testing agents, law enforcement agents, gambling regulatory bodies and government departments. Proven operational experience in e-commerce is a general requirement and specific knowledge in the areas of gambling technology, customer service and payment systems will be a distinct advantage.

The post will be based at the offices of the Commission in Alderney and involves regular international travelling. Remuneration will be in accordance with the qualifications and experience of the incumbent. The primary place of business will be Alderney, but some flexibility on location may become available for the right candidate.
