### **The Alderney eGambling (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2006**

**THE ALDERNEY GAMBLING CONTROL COMMISSION**, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 20 and 25 of the Alderney eGambling Ordinance, 2006<sup>a</sup>, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

#### **Amendment to 2006 Regulations.**

1. In regulation 340(6)(a) of the Alderney eGambling Regulations, 2006, as amended, for “seven days” substitute “at least 24 hours”.

#### **Interpretation.**

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948<sup>b</sup> applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment in force in the Island of Guernsey.

#### **Citation.**

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Alderney eGambling (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2006.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made by the Alderney Gambling Control Commission under the Alderney eGambling Ordinance, 2006 and reduce the period at which a customer's notification to an eGambling licensee increasing or removing his self-imposed limitation on his gambling activity takes effect from seven days to a minimum of 24 hours.
